Twenty-first Annual Bosque Farms Community Fair

Saturday, August 20, 1960

The Twenty-First Annual Bosque Farms Community Fair will be held at the school house on August 20, 1960. All attractions will take place at the same time as in previous years. There will be the usual basket dinner at noon. Meat, drinks and bread furnished by the Bosque Farms Association with all attending requested to bring a basket lunch.

GRAND PRIZE

- The family having the largest number of Blue Ribbons will receive a \$5.00 prize.
- B. A grand prize of \$3.00 will be given to the best exhibit in each department.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The gym will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., Friday, Aug. 19, to receive all entries except livestock and poultry. Judging of exhibits in the gym will start at 1:30 p.m. that day. Those exhibiting cut flowers can bring them in as late as 3:30 p.m. that same afternoon, to be judged.

Livestock and poultry must be on exhibit by 9:00 a.m. Saturday morning, Aug. 20, to start judging promptly at 9:30 a.m. All exhibits must remain in place until 4 o'clock except cows and milk.

- 2. The committee assumes no responsibility for exhibits.
- 3. Only one entry by any one person in each class.
- 4. No one is allowed in auditorium while judging is in progress.
- No one is to be within 25 feet of the judges while they are judging livestock.
- 6. All livestock must be tested, free of Bangs and T.B.
- 7. Decision of judges is final.
- All exhibits not listed but worthy of prize will be given a ribbon only.
- 9. Premiums will be paid in cash.
- 10. No entries, except livestock, accepted from previous years.
- 11. Persons exhibiting this year at the Fair will be:
 - All boys and girls that are members of the Bosque Farms Livestock 4-H Club or FFA.
 - All persons that take part in Bosque Farms community activities. living in Valencia County, are invited to participate.
 - Any merchant who makes a cash or merchandise donation to the fair is invited to display merchandise as in the past.
